

3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer at the Elections Office, Former Infant School Site, Page Road, Staple Hill, Bristol, BS16 4NE **Monday to Friday between 9.30 am and 4.00pm** (excluding bank holidays), beginning on Monday 25 March 2019 and closing at **4.00pm on Wednesday, 3rd April 2019**.
4. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 2nd May 2019**.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **12 midnight on Friday 12 April 2019**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
6. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at South Gloucestershire Council, PO Box 1953, Bristol, BS37 0DB by **5.00pm on Monday, 15th April 2019**.
7. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at South Gloucestershire Council, PO Box 1953, Bristol, BS37 0DB by **5.00pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2019**.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at South Gloucestershire Council, PO Box 1953, Bristol, BS37 0DB by **5.00pm on Thursday, 2nd May 2019**. The physical incapacity must have occurred **after 5.00pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2019**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person **after 5.00pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2019**.
